



BIBLE STUDY: GENESIS 1-11

First and Last Things (protology & eschatology)

WHEN: 8pm Wednesday nights on Google Meets; <https://meet.google.com/wyo-pqqj-rkr> starting April 3, and continuing weekly until June 19 [12 weeks]

WHO: Those who want to take a **deep dive** into Scripture, asking significant questions of God and the text. Yes for the beginner or even the skeptic, but not for the casual or indifferent.

WHAT: Studying Genesis 1-11, with the **goals** of:

1. hearing & responding to the **text**,
2. gaining increased confidence in how to **read the Bible**, and
3. getting introduced to the main **biblical theological themes** that play out through the one story of the Bible.

ITINERARY:

1. **April 3:** Introduction: inductive/exegetical method, primer on biblical theology, structure of Genesis, overview of Genesis 1-11 [*note: first session more teaching/orientation*]
2. **April 10:** Genesis 1-2
3. **April 17:** Genesis 1-2
4. **April 24:** Genesis 3-4
5. **May 1:** Genesis 3-4
6. **May 8:** Genesis 5-7
7. **May 15:** Genesis 5-7
8. **May 22:** Genesis 8-9
9. **May 29:** Genesis 8-9
10. **June 5:** Genesis 10-11
11. **June 12:** Genesis 10-11
12. **June 19:** margin; glimpse toward Gen. 12-50



FORMAT:

- ~10 min • Gather, sing & pray
- ~10 min • Read text together
- ~15-20min • Teaching/orientation [historical background, biblical theological highlights, etc.]
- ~40-45min • Inductive questions together:
 - *Observation*: what do I/you/we **see**?
 - *Interpretation*: what does this **mean** to me/us?
 - *Application*: what will I/we **do** about it?
- ~5min • prayer & response
